Fr. Wade Menezes, C.P.M.



is a member of the Fathers of Mercy, a missionary preaching Religious Congregation based in Auburn, Kentucky. He received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Catholic Thought from the Oratory of St. Philip Neri in Toronto, Canada and his dual Master of Arts and Master of Divinity Degrees in Theology from Holy Apostles Seminary in Cromwell, Connecticut. His secular college degrees are in journalism and communications. Fr. Wade is currently the Assistant General and has served as Director of Vocation and Director of Seminarians for the Fathers of Mercy.

Fr. Chris Alar, MIC



Father Chris entered the Marian of the Immaculate Conception, the religious community entrusted with spreading the message and devotion of Divine Mercy, as a postulant in 2006. Answering the Lord's call, he attended Franciscan University Steubenville, OH, for his Philosophy studies and earned his Masters of Divinity from Holy Apostles Seminary in Cromwell, CT. Currently he lives and works on Eden Hill in Stockbridge, MA, home of the National Shrine of The Divine Mercy, where he serves as "Fr. Joseph, MIC," the director of the Association of Marian helper.

Al Kresta



Al Kresta is a broadcaster, journalist, President and CEO of Ave Maria \ Communication, host of the nationally "Kresta in the Afternoon." In 1997, Domino's Pizza founder Tom Monaghan recruited Al to launch the media apostolate, *Ave Maria Communications*. Heard on over 350 stations and Sirius Satellite Radio, *Kresta in the Afternoon* is broadcast each weekday from 4-6 p.m. Eastern Time and looks at all areas of life through the lens of Scripture and the teaching of Christ's Church. Al is the author of the best-selling book *Dangers to the Faith: Recognizing Catholicism's 21st Century Opponents* as well as *Why Do Catholics Genueflect?, Why Are Catholics So Concerned about Sin?*, and co-author with Nick Thomm of *Moments of Grace: Inspiring Stories From Well-Known Catholics*.

Raymond Arroyo



Raymond Arroyo is an internationally known, award-winning journalist, producer, and New York Times Bestselling author. As founding News Director, Managing Editor and Lead Anchor for EWTN News, he is seen in more than 350 million homes on six continents each week and heard on more than 500 AM/FM affiliates and a stand alone Sirius channel throughout the US. was brought up in an Evangelical home in PA. After graduating from Bob Jones University, he went to study theology at Oxford University. He was eventually ordained as an Anglican priest and served as a curate, a school chaplain in Cambridge and a country parson on the Isle of Wight. Realizing that he and the Anglican Church were on divergent paths, in 1995 Fr. Dwight and his family were received into the Catholic Church. In December 2006 he was ordained as a Catholic priest under the special pastoral provision for married former Anglican clergy. He now serves as pastor of Our Lady of the Rosary parish in Greenville SC.
