## SPEAKERS

### Fr. Thomas Petri, O.P., STB, STL, STD



Fr. Thomas Petri was appointed President of the Pontifical Faculty in April 2021. He initially studied to be a priest for the Diocese of Owensboro and entered Saint Meinrad College Seminary in 1996 before moving to the Pontifical College Josephinum in 1997 where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy. He then received a Baccalaureate of Sacred Theology from the University of St. Mary of the Lake/Mundelein Seminary in Chicago in 2002. Entering the Order of Preachers in 2004, Fr. Petri was ordained a priest in 2009. He has a Licentiate in Sacred Theology from the Pontifical Faculty of the Immaculate Conception and a Doctorate in Sacred Theology from The Catholic University of America. He has published articles in *Nova et Vetera* and in *The National Catholic Bioethics Quarterly*. He is also a contributor to *Catholic News Agency* and *The National Catholic Register*.

### Dr. Michael Barber



Dr. Michael Patrick Barber is Professor of Sacred Scripture and Theology at the Augustine Institute Graduate School. He holds a Phd from Fuller Theological Seminary. He is the author of numerous scholarly publications and popular-level works. His most recent books are *The Historical Jesus and the Temple: Memory, Methodology, and the gospel of Matthew*, *The True Meaning of Christmas: The Birth of Jesus and the Origins of the Season and Salvation: What Every Catholic Should Know*. He lives in Aurora, CO, with his wife Kimberly and their six children.

### Fr. Chris Alar, MIC



Fr. Chris Alar entered the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception in 2006. Prior to that time, he received a Bachelor of Science in industrial engineering and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Michigan. After working as an engineering manager, he began his own consulting firm in NC in 2000. Answering the Lord's call, he attended Franciscan University of Steubenville, for his philosophy studies, Dominican House of Studies in Washington, D.C., for his

theology studies, and he earned his Master of Divinity degree from Holy Apostles Seminary in Cromwell, CT. He is host of the EWTN show *Living Divine Mercy*, which airs on Wednesdays, 6:30 pm EST.

### Dr. Edward Sri, STD, STL



Dr. Edward Sri is a theologian, author and well-known Catholic speaker who appears regularly on EWTN. Each year he speaks to tens of thousands of people from around the world, including clergy, parish leaders, catechists and laity. He has written several best-selling books, including *No Greater Love*, and *Who Am I to Judge?* He is a founding leader with Curtis Martin of FOCUS, where he currently serves as Sr. Vice President of Apostolic Outreach.

### Fr Christopher Smith, STD/PhD, KHS, Pastor



Fr. Smith is a native of Greenville, SC. He went to Christendom College in Front Royal, Virginia. After a year living in Rome studying at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross, he entered priestly formation at the Pontifical Roman Major Seminary. While there, he obtained a licentiate in dogmatic theology from the Gregorian University and studied French at the Institut Catholique in Paris. Fr. Smith was ordained Priest in 2005. Fr. Smith pursued a Master of Business Administration degree at the Citadel. He attended the University of Navarre in Pamplona, Spain and he received the degree of Doctor of Sacred Theology. Fr. Smith speaks Spanish, Italian, French, and some German and is pastor at Prince of Peace.
